We would like to refer to the Official Memo from the Registrar Office dated 30th Mar 2020, kindly take note that:

- 1. Current UNISEL international students (Registered resident students only) who are staying off-campus during the semester holiday, you are encouraged to return to your hostel (check-in) from 15 19 Apr 2020. Any matters concerning to the hostel check-in kindly refers to your Residential Fellow. Please take note, on your arrival at the main gate of University entrance you will be asked to perform a \*health screening procedures.
- 2. Current UNISEL international students who are now at overseas / home-country during the semester holiday, you will ^not be able to return to Malaysia until after 14 Apr 2020 (Movement Control Order ended). Please take note, on your arrival at the Malaysian Airports, you will be asked to perform a ^^health screening procedures.
- 3. Health check will be conducted at all entrance of the University to make sure the students are healthy. Students who failed in the health check will refuse entry and ask to return home or seek medical treatment.
- 4. Please be reminded, you are advised to perform your new semester registration via online through **i-Daftar** (3-14 Apr 2020 for current students).
- 5. You are also required to participate in the online-lecture via e-learning portal (6 Apr 22 May 2020).
- 6. The Face-to-Face lecture, will be starting on **1 Jun 17 Jul 2020.**
- 7. Please adhere to the important date as stipulated in Official Memo from the Registrar Office dated 30th Mar 2020, or refer more information at the Student's Portal <a href="http://studentportal.unisel.edu.my">http://studentportal.unisel.edu.my</a>

A Before hostel check-in, you (travelling domestic) are required to complete a self-declaration on health status, and your body temperature will be recorded at the main gate of the University entrance by the UNISEL Security Officer. If your health screening shows any symptoms of COVID-19, you are **not allowed** to enter UNISEL Campus, and you are required to go to the nearest Government Quarantine Center for 14 days self-quarantine.

^^^ Upon your arrival at the Malaysian Airports, you (travelling overseas) are required to complete a self-declaration on health status, and your body temperature will be recorded at the Airport by the respective Authority. If your health screening shows any symptoms of COVID-19, you will be sent to the nearby Hospital by the Authority. If your health screening did not show any symptoms of COVID-19, you are required to go to the nearest Government Quarantine Center for 14 days self-quarantine.
