1	The competition is open to all international students who are studyin at Public Universities and Private Higher Educational Institutions i Malaysia.		
2	The participants should have an active student status in the current semester of studies.		
3	The competition is organized by the Department of Higher Education (DoHE) in collaboration with Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM), Institut Terjemahan & Buku Malaysia (ITBM) and Dewan Bahasa dan Pustaka (DBP).		
4	The competition is open to all levels of education (Bachelor's, Master's and PhD) and participants must not be on special leave.		
5	The participation is free.		
6	The competition will be held from 1 July to 30 August 2021.		
7	Entries are allowed only in Bahasa Malaysia.		
8	Each participating group should comprise of one (1) to three (3) member(s).		
9	Each entry may include the public/ family members/ friends as supporting actors.

- 19 If participants use any of the items specified in item 18, they must record the copyright usage in their video description before uploading it to the official website of the competition.
- 20 The format of the video is as follows: -
 - 1. The video must be recorded in a bright setting.
 - 2. Must use first-person point of view which is "saya".
 - 3. Video production must be creative and clear in terms of audio and video images.
 - 4. The surrounding must not be noisy. Participants are encouraged to close the air channels such as fans, air conditioners, and windows and must not record the video inside of a car.
 - 5. The maximum video duration is 6 minutes.
 - 6. The camera must be static (not shaky).
 - 7. Videos can be produced in the form of dialogues, short sketches, or other new techniques that are deemed rational.
 - 8. The video produced should display the noble values of Malaysian society such as patriotism, unity, and respect.
 - 9. The video entry must not have previously won any kind of film or movie competition.
 - 10. The videos produced should not offend any party and must not contain sensitive issues including political, racial, and religious beliefs.
 - 11. Participants must use their own recording equipment either using a smartphone or a video recorder to create a video based on their own creativity where acting elements or other elements are allowed.

21 Participants must ensure that the entries submitted do not contain either partial or full use of images, videos, or any input / material owned by others. If there is any violation of the law on the production of video, all liability is under the responsibility of the participants. 22 All expenses for the production of short videos are under the responsibility of the participants themselves.
