Please be informed that application for 'Mevlana Exchange Programme' for 2020/2021 session has opened. The purpose of the programme is to have exchange of academic staff and students between Universiti Selangor, Malaysia and **Sakarya University, Turkey**.

2. Amendments have been made with regard to 2020 – 2021 Academic Year Exchange Programme criteria and Codes of Practice of Turkish Council of Higher Education, the responsible institution for the Programme. These amendments introduce quotas for several countries and/or education fields.

3. Please be informed that applications, which do not conform to such criteria or codes, will be deemed invalid. Preliminary results will be announced early April, while final lists will be notified by the Higher Education Council at a later date.

4. Requirement for students selection include :

- i. A minimum of 2.50/4.00 grade point average for Bachelor's degree students, and
- ii. A minimum of 3.00/4.00 grade point average for Master's and PhD students are required.

5. Selection process will be in 2 two steps :

- i. Through the applicant lists. (Department confirmity, GPA and exct.)
- ii. Through the applicants documents (Transcript, application form, work plan exct.)

6. All documents must be in softcopy form and computer-typed (*hand written is not accepted, except signature*). Final date for submission of documents to International Office is **on/before 5 March 2020** through email ***mobility@unisel.edu.my***.
